



MINOR INFORMATION

- The fashion minor is the junction where fashion meets business. The fashion minor consists of 6 courses, which are offered during the Fall and Spring semesters, as well as during the Summer sessions. Students have the ability to complete the fashion minor in two summers.
- The curriculum currently offers introductory courses in fashion forecasting, fashion promotion, textiles, research, data analysis, economic management, and managing apparel productions and people. You will graduate with a strong working knowledge of apparel product development, apparel manufacturing, textile application, and the ability to utilize technology not only for analysis, but also for communication and marketing. You will also understand market trends as well as popular styles in a specific location(s), culture, age, and economic groups.

MINOR REQUIREMENTS:

- **The minor consists of 18 total units**
- **Lower division** coursework is recommended to be completed before upper division coursework

- Interested students must complete a **Fashion Minor Information Session** and Quiz Online. **A 2.0 GPA is required to declare**
- Courses used in the Fashion Minor may not be applied to a student's major or second minor.
