



MINOR INFORMATION

HDFS is a great minor for students who are interested in understanding human development, and improving the quality of life for individuals, couples, families, and communities.

MINOR REQUIREMENTS:

- 6 classes (18 units total)
- 3 of the 6 classes (9 units) must be upper division (300-499 level)
- HDFS 117 Lifespan Human Development is a recommended first course, as it is a prerequisite to most upper division HDFS coursework. HDFS 117 will prepare students for their higher level HDFS classes.
- Review the HDFS prerequisite guide on our website to see the classes we recommend taking first, before enrolling in upper level HDFS classes

MINOR POLICIES:

- Interested students must complete an **HDFS Minor Information Session** and Quiz Online in order to declare the HDFS Minor
- **HDFS 150B1 cannot be used in the HDFS Minor**, it is only approved to be used as a general education course

ENROLLMENT INFORMATION:

- When enrolling for fall and spring semesters, HDFS minors must wait to enroll in all HDFS courses during **open registration**
- Minors are **encouraged to take summer coursework** to complete the HDFS Minor, since minors are not guaranteed seats in HDFS courses during the fall and spring semesters
