Incomplete applications will not be reviewed and will be automatically denied. Paper applications will no longer be accepted. Please submit all materials via this online application.

Through the online application you will have the ability to upload various requirements for consideration by the admission committee. For this application you will be asked to upload the following:

1. Personal Statement of Interests and Goals
2. Resume/ Curriculum Vitae
3. The names and contact information of who will be submitting Letters of Recommendation on your behalf.

DO NOT send hard copies of application materials unless specifically requested by the school in a separate email.

Statement of Purpose

Please provide a Statement of Purpose indicating the academic and professional goals you hope to achieve in pursuit of this program of study.

Personal Statement - Please upload a two-to-four page, double-spaced statement describing your scholarly and professional interests and goals. Please be sure to address the following issues in your statement, including any additional information that you feel is important for us to know when considering your application. Remember, this is your opportunity to describe your qualifications for and interest in the Human Development and Family Science graduate program to the members of the HDFS Graduate Committee.

- Describe your motivation for pursuing graduate study at this time. Why have you chosen this field of study?
- Within the field of Human Development and Family Science, what are your specific interests? Discuss specific research topics which are of interest to you. Why do you see this as an important topic to study? Is there a particular faculty member in our division with whom you would like to work?
- What are your long term professional goals? How do you see this program as helping you meet those goals?

Letters of Recommendation

Applicants are required to provide 3 Letters of Recommendation.

The Norton School of Human Ecology requires that each applicant have a minimum of three letters of recommendation submitted on their behalf. These letters should be written by faculty or employers who can speak about your academic and research ability. 1. Resume/Curriculum Vitae - Please upload your current resume or Curriculum Vitae which includes education, honors, memberships and participation in professional organizations, employment history, teaching-related experiences, research and scholarly activities and publications.
2. Teaching /Professional Experience - Please provide us with a list of all teaching and other professional positions you have held to date, beginning with the most recent. Please include employer, position title and dates. If you do not have any teaching or professional experience, please type NA
3. Publications - Please provide us with a list of the titles of all publication, including thesis titles, giving full bibliographic references. If you do not have any publications, please type NA
4. Writing Sample - Please upload a sample of your academic writing
5. Honors - Please provide us with a list of all honors, scholarships, prizes, honorary societies, etc. If you do not have anything to list, please type NA
6. Academic History - Have you ever been on academic probation or found it necessary to withdraw from school temporarily for academic reasons? If so, please explain in full. If not, please type "NA"
7. GPA below 3.0 - If your undergraduate GPA is below the minimum required 3.0, please upload a letter of explanation
8. Graduating Class - What was your numerical or percentile rank in your graduating class from your undergraduate institution? Please include the size of your graduating class. If this information is not available please type "unknown"
9. Funding - Please indicate the extent to which you will have to rely upon University-provided financial assistance. (Not at All, Minimally, Moderately, Mostly, Totally)
10. Additional Information – A number of departments pay serious attention to professionally related experience and may have an affirmative action policy relative to minority groups. If you care to supply information on either of these matters, please upload a statement here
